

"We invite you to Dziegielów, a small village situated in the South of Poland, at the border of the Czech Republic. There are 1,200 people living here.

For many years Dziegielów has been believed to be a special place. All that is thanks to Mission Weeks which have been held here for fifty years. Around 2,000 people, not only Protestants, come here every year to take part in this event. During the Evangelizations, people gather in a huge tent to listen to the Gospel, to worship God, to pray, and to take part in seminars. The Center of Mission and Evangelization is the organizer. This Mission Week is the result of a serious attitude toward Jesus' words: "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation." Every year the inhabitants of our village take part and help with the organization by giving shelter to guests.

Dziegielów congregation is an affiliation of the Cieszyn parish. It consists of 640 inhabitants of the village and residents of EBEN EZER – an old people's home led by deaconesses. Our church activities include Sunday services, Sunday Schools, Bible meetings, Youth meetings, and choir meetings. Our congregation loves singing. There are four different music groups.

We also help people from the outside. We help financially, remembering about spreading the Good News. For example, in July 2003, we organized a Mission Camp for the children from Bieszczady (the mountains in the south-eastern area of Poland).

In the future, we would like to continue both our evangelistic and mission activities in our area and outside of it. We also pray for help needed to enlarge our chapel, which is too small for our needs.

By presenting our activities, we would like to ask you to pray that these words of our Lord: "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters..." are present in everything we do."
